

FES CORPORATE LICENSE AGREEMENT

Edition: Corporate License

This Corporate License Agreement (“Agreement”) is a legal contract between you (“Licensee”) and **PORTALZ PTY LTD**, Australia (“Licensor”), governing use of the FES Framework Corporate Edition (“Software”).

By installing, accessing, or using the Software, Licensee agrees to all terms of this Agreement.

If Licensee does not agree, the Software may not be installed or used.

1. Definitions

1.1 “Software”

Means the FES Framework Corporate Edition, including all binaries, DLLs, libraries, tools, documentation, and related materials provided by Licensor.

1.2 “Developer”

Means a human individual who writes, compiles, builds, or otherwise uses the Software in development.

1.3 “Deployed Unit”

Means a distributed copy of any Licensee product that embeds or includes the FES Framework DLL or any FES-derived encryption functions.

1.4 “Corporate Use”

Means use within a company, corporation, partnership, business entity, organization, non-profit, or any team of more than one developer.

1.5 “Shield Modules”

Means optional premium FES features described in Section 6.

2. Grant of License

2.1 Corporate License Grant.

Licensor grants Licensee a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Software for internal corporate development and product deployment under the terms of this Agreement.

2.2 Developer Limit.

This license permits use by up to **25 developers**.

Additional developers require purchase of Developer Add-On Packs.

2.3 Deployment Limit.

Licensee may distribute up to **10,000 deployed units** of products incorporating the Software.

Additional deployment requires purchase of Deployed Unit Add-On Packs.

2.4 Redistribution of Compiled DLL.

Licensee may redistribute the FES DLL **only as part of compiled Licensee products** and only within the deployment limits.

2.5 No Source Access.

This license does not grant access to source code.

2.6 Perpetual Basis.

Licensee may purchase:

- A perpetual license for the current major version (2.x), and
- Additional Deployed Unit and/or Developer Add-On Packs

2.7 Secure Licensee Portal.

Corporate Licensees are provided access to a secure Licensee Portal associated with their licensed identity.

The Portal is intended to provide an electronic, authoritative view of license-related information, which may include:

- Current license(s) and status
- Licensed editions and entitlements
- Requests for Deployed Unit and/or Developer Add-On Packs
- Download installation software
- Download software license files (.feslic)

Access to the Licensee Portal and available functions may vary by edition, jurisdiction, and deployment context.

3. Restrictions

Licensee must not:

- sublicense, rent, lease, or disclose the DLL separately
- allow more than 25 developers to use the Software without add-ons
- exceed 10,000 deployed units without add-ons
- reverse engineer, decompile, modify, or tamper with the Software
- use the Software in military, defense, or classified systems (Defence Edition required)
- redistribute the DLL unmodified or unbound to Licensee products
- use the Software in any manner prohibited by Australian export law

Violation terminates this Agreement immediately.

4. Deployment Add-Ons

4.1 Deployed Unit Add-Ons.

Licensee may purchase additional deployment blocks in increments defined by Licensor (e.g., **10,000-unit add-ons**).

4.2 License Capacity.

Each add-on is recorded in the licensee's secure login the new deployment quota to the Corporate License.

4.3 No Expiration.

Purchased deployment capacity is perpetual for the licensed major version.

5. Developer Add-Ons

5.1 Developer Packs.

Licensee may purchase additional Developer Packs (e.g., +25 developers per pack).

5.2 Assignment.

Developer Packs bind to the Corporate License and do not require renegotiation of terms.

6. FES Shield Add-Ons

Corporate Licensees may optionally purchase premium security modules:

6.1 Transformed Silo Files (Add-On)

Password-protected, FES encrypted Silo files that must be unlocked before use.

6.2 Silo Hierarchies (Add-On)

Parent–child Silo dependency chains enabling multi-tiered security structures.

6.3 Per-Dimension Silos

Not available under the Corporate License.

Reserved exclusively for Military Edition due to security classification.

Add-ons are licensed per company and bind to the Corporate License.

7. Internal Records and Compliance

7.1 Record Keeping.

Licensee agrees to maintain internal records of:

- number of developers using the Software,
- number of deployed units distributed,
- any purchased add-on packs.

7.2 Self-Attestation.

Upon request, Licensee shall provide written confirmation of compliance.

7.3 Right to Request Verification.

Licensors may request reasonable verification in cases of suspected violation.

No invasive or automatic telemetry is used.

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- fitness for a particular purpose
- correctness
- stability
- non-infringement

Licensee assumes all risks.

10. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by Queensland law:

Licensor shall not be liable for:

- direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, special, or exemplary damages
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- business interruption
- loss of data
- security breaches
- deployment failure
- or any claim exceeding the license fee paid

even if advised of the possibility of such damages.

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This Agreement terminates automatically if Licensee:

- exceeds developer or deployment limits without add-ons
- uses the Software in prohibited contexts (e.g., military)
- reverse engineers or modifies the Software
- violates any clause of this Agreement
- or fails to comply with audit requests

Upon termination, Licensee must cease use and delete all copies.

12. Governing Law

This Agreement is governed by the laws of **Queensland, Australia**, without regard to conflict-of-law provisions.

Licensee agrees to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Queensland.

13. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the complete and sole agreement between Licensee and PORTALZ PTY LTD regarding the Corporate Edition of FES Framework.

No verbal or informal statements modify this Agreement.

Acceptance

By installing, accessing, or using the FES Framework Corporate Edition, Licensee acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agree to all terms.
